



A585 Norcross roundabout improvement

We'd like to invite you to find out more about our plans to reduce congestion and improve people's journeys at Norcross roundabout on the A585.

On Wednesday 27 February 2019, we'll be at Thornton Methodist Church where we'll be showcasing the improvements we're planning to make later this year as part of the Government's £220 million Congestion Relief Fund.

What we are planning

We plan to increase the size of the roundabout, widen the approaches to the junction and install traffic signal controls. We also plan to improve safety and connectivity by introducing signal-controlled pedestrian crossings.

Why we need to make improvements

Congestion is already a problem here and traffic is expected to grow. And with construction of the new A585 Windy

Harbour to Skippool dual carriageway expected to take place between spring 2020 and 2022, there is growing demand to accommodate future traffic growth.

The scheme will help to support the delivery of the economic and housing strategies of the three local councils of Wyre, Fylde and Blackpool, as set out in their respective local plans.
