Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to inform you about an upcoming change regarding our school cardigans and jumpers. Our recent Ofsted highlighted that the current font on our cardigans, jumpers and signage was not user friendly, particularly for our younger pupils learning to read.

Current logo:



After careful consideration, and consultation with our Parent/Carer Forum, we have made the decision to update the text on these items to better reflect the school's current branding and to ensure consistency across our uniform.

New logo:



What is changing?

Starting in September 2025, the logo on all school cardigans and jumpers will be updated in line with the rest of uniform and part of our ongoing commitment to enhancing the appearance of our school logo.

We are also updating the PE t-shirts with a logo on the top right in a better quality fabric than the current t-shirt. We are also introducing an optional navy tracksuit with a logo hoodie and plain bottoms. There are some samples in the school office if you wish to see them before they become available.

When will this happen?

To ensure a smooth transition and minimise any inconvenience, this change will be phased in over a two-year period, beginning in September 2025. This will give families time to adjust and purchase new items as needed.

What does this mean for current uniform items?

Any cardigans or jumpers with the current text will still be acceptable for wear during this phased transition period. We understand that it may take time for families to purchase new items, and we want to ensure that this change does not place undue financial pressure on our families. At this present time, there is no increase to the price of the new jumpers, cardigans and PE t-shirts.

How can you prepare?

If you wish to purchase new jumpers and cardigans with the updated text, they will be available after Easter at Bispham Clothing. We will inform you once they are in stock. In the meantime, there is no immediate action required on your part.

We are excited about this update and hope it will help us to further strengthen our school community and sense of pride. Should you have any questions or concerns about this change, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Drop-off & Pick-up Arrangements

Dear Foundation Stage Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, the work on our new outdoor area is set to commence after the Easter break. In light of this, there will be some adjustments to the beginning and end of day arrangements for our Foundation Stage (FS) children. These changes are outlined below:

- **Morning Drop-Off (8.40am- 8.55am):** FS children should now be dropped off at the little blue and yellow gate next to the Year 1 and 2 play equipment on the Year 1 and 2 playground. Teachers will be there to greet the children as usual.
- **End of the Day (3.10pm):** At the end of the school day, Yellow Class will exit from the Year 1 door, while Red and Blue Classes will exit from the little blue and yellow gate at which they were dropped off. Teachers will be with the children as they exit as usual.
- **Congestion Management:** We kindly ask that you stand back and move forward as your child reaches the front of the line to avoid any unnecessary congestion.
