Milk in School

The children in Reception should by now have received a leaflet from Blackpool Council about the Fluoridated milk Primary School Scheme. This is the type of milk recommended by the NHS Clinical Lead of Dental Services in Blackpool from Year 1 onwards.

We will shortly be sending out a survey to all parents of children in Reception through to Year 5 asking you to choose which milk your child would like from September.

This survey must be completed by 4pm on Friday 11th July, so that we can place the order before we break up for the summer holidays.

When you get the link, please complete it as soon as you can, as we will be unable to make additions in time for the return in September, if it is not completed on time.

Please complete it even if your child does not want milk or cannot have milk for whatever reason. Unfortunately, there is no option for an alternative to milk offered by the milk company.

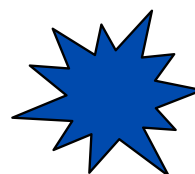
Attendance Matters

One more week to go until our attendance winners are announced! The class who has received the weekly attendance award most this term, will be rewarded with an attendance party in school on Tuesday 15th July.

Attendance per class is shared and celebrated in whole-school assembly each week and the class with the highest attendance are presented with our attendance award to display proudly on their classroom door. The class who has won the weekly attendance award the most times across a term win the Attendance Reward. The reward for the spring term was won by Class 6 and they enjoyed a trip to The Backlot Cinema to watch Dogman. This term's winners will have the choice of a visit from the ice cream van, a silent disco on the school field, another cinema trip or something else (to be decided by the children).

At the end of each term, children who have achieved 100% attendance receive a special 100% attendance badge. 100% attendance across one term earns the children a bronze badge. If they achieve 100% attendance across two terms, they receive a silver badge and anyone who achieves 100% attendance across the entire year, receives a special gold badge. So far this year, Mrs Hylton has presented 245 bronze badges and 61 silver badges. At the end of the summer term, the final set of badges will be awarded and we are confident we'll have more bronze and silver as well as some gold badges to present.

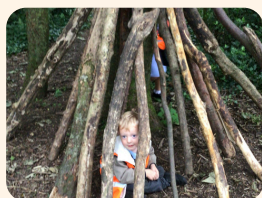

In maths, Year 1 have been practicing their number line and collaborative skills. We are hoping to be able to get to 100 this week



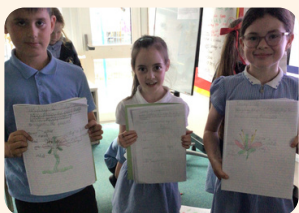
Year 2

Year 2 are really enjoying their learning in computing, using the Scratch Junior coding app.



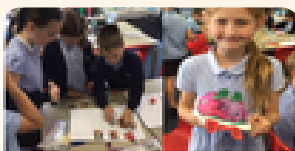
Year 3
